

INDIANA TECH - ENTRY REQUIREMENTS (All Programs)

	Student Background	Entry Requirements	
1	Completed a 4-year bachelor's degree program	 The maximum acceptable backlogs is 30. A CGPA of 50% or higher is required. 	
2	Completed a 3-year bachelor's degree program from an " A Accredited " university in India. You can click here to know your university's accreditation.	 The maximum acceptable backlogs is 15. A CGPA of 60% or higher is required. 	
3	Completed a 3-year bachelor's degree program from an " B Accredited " university in India. You can click here to know your university's accreditation.	 A master's degree is mandatory. If undergraduate CGPA falls between 50-60%, the corresponding master's CGPA must be 60% or higher. If undergraduate CGPA is 60% or higher, the corresponding master's CGPA must be 50% or higher. 	
4	Laterally transferred from a Polytechnic Diploma program.	 The maximum allowable backlog limit of 30 includes both the three-year undergraduate degree and the one-year Polytechnic diploma. Both documents are required for consideration. 	



INDIANA TECH - UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Indiana Tech has restrictions on acceptable undergraduate degrees for certain master's programs. Please find these restrictions below:

	Program	Undergraduate Degree Requirement
1	Master of Business Administration	Required an undergraduate degree (any field)
2	Master of Business Administration (STEM)	Students from non-STEM backgrounds will need to take a Bootcamp class (3 credits).
3	Master of Science - Engineering Management	Requires a STEM undergraduate degree in Engineering or Information Systems related fields.
4	Master of Science - Information Systems	Requires a Business or STEM undergraduate degree
5	Master of Science - Cybersecurity	Requires an undergraduate degree in Information Systems or a Computer Science related field.
